Legislative Achievements

- Supported Employment Fund size multiplier to help local businesses in our area by slowing the rate of unemployment insurance cost. **(HO428)**
- Supported Human resources equivalency that encourage state agencies to take a skill-based hiring approach. **(HO433)**



Public Safety Initiatives

- Supported amending existing law to revise provisions regarding accepted voter identification at the polls. **(H0124)**

Protecting Families

- Supported amending existing law to provide that a residential care or assisted living facility resident shall be entitled to in-person visitation subject to certain precautions. **(H0064)**
- Supported adding to existing law to provide for limited licenses for medical school graduates who are not accepted into a residency program. **(H0153)**
- Supported amending existing law to clarify that certain schools and after-school programs do not need a daycare license. **(H0212a)**
- Supported adding to existing law to prohibit the use of merchant firearms codes. **(H0295)**
- Supported Counseling Compact to expand access to counseling. **(HO393)**
- Supported further funding to understand Maternal Mortality rates. **(HO399)**
- Opposed Medicaid Expansion as it would upend the current Medicaid expansion. **(HO419)**





Protecting personal property rights

- Supported amending existing law to provide that charging a fee for any statement of a unit owner's or member's account is a violation of specified law. **(H0157)**
- Supported adding to existing law to establish the Unfair Service Agreements Act. **(H0158)**



Healthcare Access

- Opposed Medicaid Expansion changes that would've harmfully upended the current Medicaid system. **(H0213)**



Agriculture Initiatives

- Supported amending existing law to clarify that animal remedies for certain animals that include ingredients from industrial hemp are not considered adulterated. **(H0095)**
- Supported Records Wildlife to help preserve wildlife herds. **(H0404)**



Education Advancements

- Supported amending existing law to provide for the hiring of employees under approved apprenticeship programs. **(H0016)**
- Supported amending and adding to existing law to establish the Idaho Launch Grant Program and to revise provisions regarding the In-Demand Careers Fund. **(H0024)**
- Supported amending existing law to remove school bond and levy election dates in August and March. **(H0058a)**
- Supported adding to existing law to require financial literacy courses in certain grades. **(H0092)**
- Supported Public Charter Schools. **(H0386)**
